### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to a depth of 4708' before acid treatment was attempted. We planned to treat separately a pay from 4530' to 4537' and another from 4601' to 4609'. Gel seal was put in the hole and filled it back from 4702' to 4549'. Formation above this point was then treated with 1500 gallons of acid. After treatment, hole was swabbed dry. The gel seal was then flushed from the hole and the entire line section retreated with 3000 gallons of acid. After acid no appreciable increase in oil was noted so a decision was made to deepen the hole before further treatment.
