## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Completion Total Depth, 5194'. 5 1/2" casing cemented at 4222' with 200 sacks.

In an effort to complete this well as a small commercial producer, it was plugged back with pea gravel to 4796' and with 4 sacks of cement and 16 gallons of plastic to 4743' to shut off bottom hole water. The well was then bailed down and tested 1/4 bailer of water per hour with a small amount of oil. After shooting on 9-25-45 from 4690' to 4735' with 110 quarts of nitroglycerin and cleaning out to plugged-back depth, 4743', the well produced 5 barrels of oil in 2 hours and pumped off on 10-21-45. Since that time, production has settled at less
