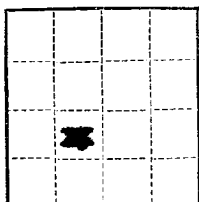

DETAILS OF WORK

I propose to drill this well to an approximate total depth of 4800' to test the Queen formation. Both the top of the Queen and the Penrose formation in middle Queen. Approximately 300' of 8-5/8" OD Surface Casing will be run and cemented back to the surface. If production is obtained 5-1/2" Casing will be set through production zones and cemented with 400 sacks of Pozmix Cement with 4% gel, and 125 sacks of neat cement.

Rotary Tools will be used.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
