left in the well by Harrington during his re-entry attempt Laring 1969. Junk in hole was encountered at a depth of 2600', approximately 1945' above previously produced Queen sand at a depth of 4545'.

Efforts to get past this junk were unsuccessful, and subsequent to verbal approval given to Armer's Chandler Haggard by the NMOCC's Joe Ramey, the subject well was plugged and abandoned on May 7, 1974 as follows: 25 sx. cement plug in 5-1/2" OD casing 1550-1800', 25 sx. cement plug in 5-1/2" OD casing 50-300', and 15 sx. cement plug at surface with 4-1/2" OD plugged and abandoned marker.
