General Operating Company assumed ownership of the Scharbauer Cattle Company #2 well (shut-in) from Millard Deck Oil Company effective January 1, 1975.

Before placing the well back on production during May, 1975 from existing perforations in the Upper Queen sand from 4526'-4616' overall, the well was cleaned out below the 4 1/2" OD casing shoe at 4720' to its original total depth of 4855' to open the Penrose (Lower Queen) sand from 4815'-20' for production.

On pump test on May 14, 1975, the well produced 6 barrels of oil and 33 barrels of water in a twenty-four (24) hour period with gas too small to measure.
