On December 25th, at 10:30 PM, 48 hours will have elapsed since 1916 feet of 8-5/8" 32# Seamless SH Casing was cemented with 450 sacks; at which time we propose to test casing shut-off in the following manner: Build up a pressure of 1000# and hold for 30 minutes and if test is OK, drill the cement plug and again build up a pressure of 1000# to be held for 30 minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
