DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 10:00 P. M. December 10, 1944, 76 hours had elapsed since setting 13" SH 50# Casing at 314' with 250 sacks of cement. Casing shut-off was tested in the following manner: A pressure of 400# was built up and held for 30 minutes and shut-off tested OK. The cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 400# was again built up and as this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
