The subject well was completed 7-21-60 for an initial daily potential of 208 BO, no water, with 229 MCFG, flowing. GOR 1101. TD 4705'. Producing interval 4562-74'. The well frequently dies because of insufficient reservoir energy and must be swabbed to restore production.

In order to restore top allowable production and eliminate swabbing costs, permission is requested to install artificial lift equipment.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of the above work.
