FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The subject well was completed June 2, 1959 in the Wolfcamp formation 11,106-11,507'. The well declined to the point where it was a non-commercial producer and was shut in 1-16-61. Permission is requested to plug and abandon the well in the following manner: Displace water in casing with 9 PPG mud, pull approximately 5,500' 7" casing, dump 100 sacks cement at top of parted tubing (8,000'), spot 25 sacks cement at 5,000', pull 5 5/8" casing (approximately 1,100'), spot 15 sacks cement at 385' and 15 sacks at surface. A 4" by 4" marker will be erected at surface and the location restored to its original condition. A subsequent report will be submitted after completion of the above work.
