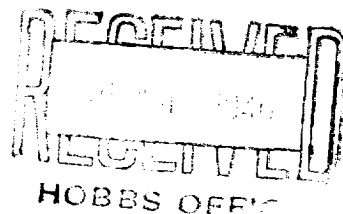

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4634 Lime. Shot well with 360 qts. SNG from 4451' to 4608'. Used gravel and calseal tamp. Cleaned out to bottom with Appleby reverse circulation process. Tubed with 2" to 4632'. Swabbed out circulating oil. Swabbed 97 bbls. fresh oil in 13 hours 5-11-40, and 1200' oil was standing in hole at end of test. 5-14-40 swabbed 60 bbls. fresh oil in 8 hours and 1500' oil was standing in hole at end of test. Well was then shut in to prepare for installation of pumping equipment.
