T. D. 4600 Lime. Loaded hole with oil. Acidized with 500 gals Dowell XXWF-6, using 17 bbls oil flush. Tubing and casing pressure 1100#. Packer not set. No break. Swabbed out oil load and acid. No indication of increase. Loaded hole with oil. Acidized with 750 gals Dowell XXWF-6 from 4230-4600. Bled off 22 bbls oil. Set packer and flushed with 18 bbls oil. Maximum tubing pressure 1200#. Swabbed out oil load. Swabbed 31 bbls oil 24 hours.
