3. Treat perforated interval with 6000 gallons acid.
4. Move in and rig up pulling unit.
5. Sub well on production and release pulling unit.
6. Conduct production tests.

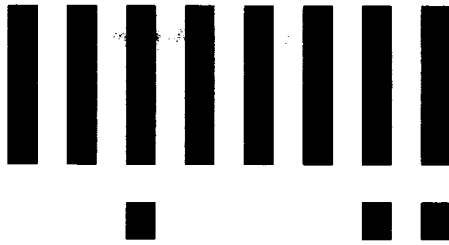
