Plug down at 8:30 p.m. 9-6-61. After waiting on cement 8 hours, cut off casing and nipples up the appol. Top of cement at 3250' by temperature survey. After waiting on cement total 18 hours, pressure tested 5 1/2" casg with 1500 psi for 30 mins. OK. Rig released 9-7-61.
