## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

All of the wells listed above with the exception of Santa Fe #39 are located in Section 5-18S-35E. Well #39 is being drilled in the NW/4 of Section 4-18S-35E, as shown on the attached plat, and is the only Phillips Petroleum Company well in Section 4. Upon completion of #39 it is desired to produce this well, along with the other five wells into what is known as #3 tank battery, which consists of five 210-bbl. welded steel tanks. These six wells can be efficiently produced into one central tank battery, provided an exception will be made to the Oil Conservation Commission ruling against flowing more than five wells into one central tank battery. Unless this exception is granted, it will be necessary to set an additional separator and two additional stock tanks for one well (#39), which involves a considerable expenditure.
