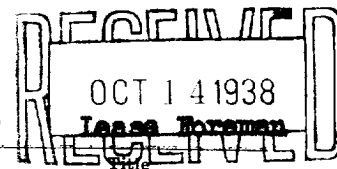

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4650' Lime. Loaded hole with 140 barrels oil & introduced 1000 gallons Dowell XX. Bled off 9-1/4 barrels oil from casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from bottom back up to 4200'. Swabbed 4 hours to 3000' and well started flowing. Recovered 165 barrels oil load & acid during 4 hours swabbing & 2 hours flowing & started test. Flowed 118 barrels fresh oil, 0 water in 8-1/2 hours. Gas estimated at 200,000 cu. ft. daily. Well was shut in after above test.
