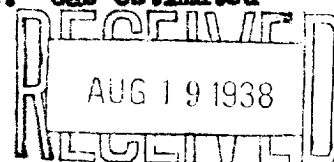

T. D. 4637 Lime. Acid treated pay formation from 4335' to total depth with 1000 gallons Dowell XX. After introducing acid, swabbed 3 hours recovering 187 bbls. oil load, and acid. ~~formation~~ Swabbed to approximately 2000'. After swabbing 3 hours well came to life and flowed 197 bbls. fresh oil, 0 water in 8 hours. Gas estimated at 500,000 cu. ft. daily.
