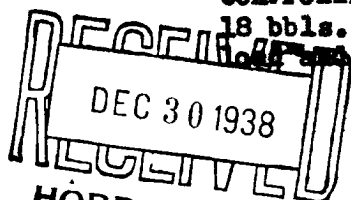

T. D. 4680 Line. Loaded hole with 180 bbls. oil & introduced 4000 gal. Dowell XX.  
Rled 30 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing,  
controlling treatment from 4190' to total depth. Flushed tubing with  
18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 25 hours, recovering 245 bbls. oil  
and acid. Pulled tubing to deepen.
