DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4640 Lime. Ran tubing with packer set 3975' 6". Loaded annular space above packer with 125 bbls. oil and introduced 2500 gallons Dowell "XXWF-6". Flushed tubing with 24 bbls. oil and started swabbing. Swabbed out oil load and acid into pits 4 hours, no gauge. Next 9 hours swabbed 51 bbls. fresh oil, no water, swabbing off bottom. Well was then shut in to reset packer and acid treat again.
