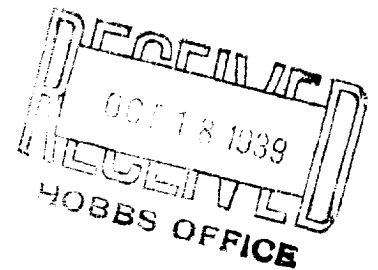

T. D. 1590 Anhydrite. Ran 55 joints 9-5/8" OD casing set at 1562' 1". Cemented with 700 sacks Trinity Common cement. Cement did not circulate. Dumped in 10 sacks Trinity Common cement around 9-5/8" casing and brought cement up to bottom of cellar.

Test for casing shut-off will be made 8:30 PM October 10, 1939.
