DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4561 Lime. Loaded hole with oil. Acidized with*2000 gallons Dowell XXWF6. Maximum pressure casing 2100# tubing 2100#, minimum casing 1400#, tubing 300#. Bled off 24 bbls oil. Acid went into formation at 300# and built up to 2100# at end of 17 bbl oil flush. Recovered oil and acid load. Swabbed 9 1/2 bbls fresh oil 14 hours.

***-C102 filed for only 1500 gallon treatment, however after acidizing began plans were changed to increase treatment to 2000 gallons.**
