## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We request permission to use a central tank battery to receive the production from the following five wells:- State of New Mexico "R" (Lease No. 55035) Well Nos. 1,2,3, & 5, located in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 6, T-18-S, R-35-E, and State of New Mexico "AB" (Lease No. 54528) Well No. 1 located in the SE 1/4 of Sec. 6, T-18-S, R-35-E.

This common tank battery will be located in the East half of Sec. 6

as shown in the attached sketch and will receive the production from this portion of these two leases, which are both Lieu Land. This central tank battery will include adequate tankage and other equipment, so that the production from each well can be accurately determined at reasonable intervals.

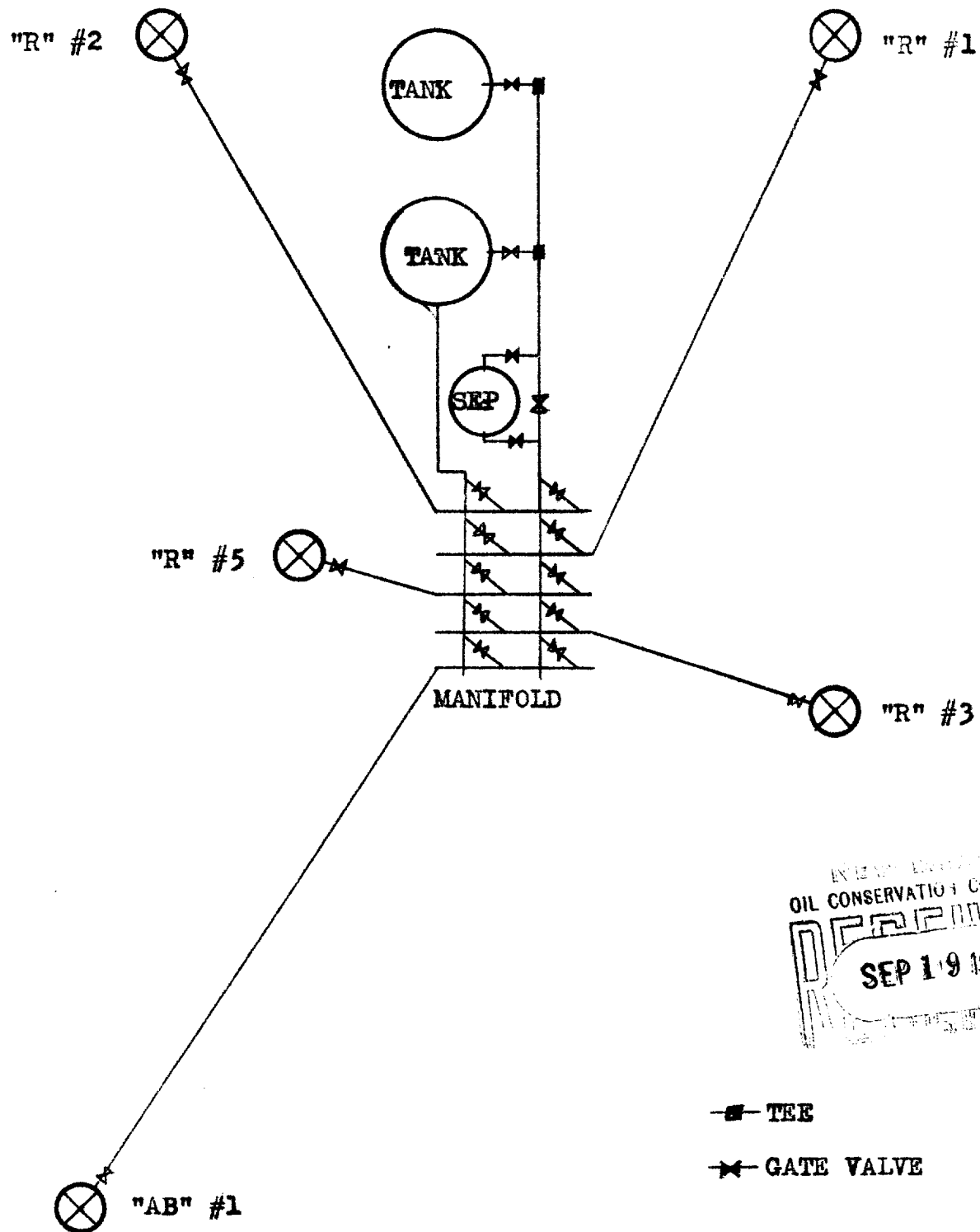
