## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A the total depth of 4907' the well produced 100% salt water on an 8 hour bailing test. The water rose to within 800' of the surface and could not be lowered by bailing approximately 4 barrels per hour. The hole swabbed dry at 4875' and cores below that depth showed no saturation.

Plugged back from 4907' to 4148' with 85 sacks of cement. The 5 1/2" casing, which had been cemented at 4238' with 250 sacks, was parted at 2700' and pulled. The hole was filled with mud before pulling the 5 1/2" casing. A cement plug (10 sacks) was spotted in the 7-5/8" casing at 1250' and 500' of this string pulled. Completed plugging on 6-20-38. Witnessed by cementing a 4" pipe marker in the top of the surface casing.
