Well was drilled to TD of 3350' in February, 1962. 13 3/8" OD 48# 11-40 casing was set at 375'. No productive oil formations were encountered. Well was temporarily abandoned until deeper zones could be evaluated in offset well. No cement plugs were placed in hole. Hole was left full of drilling fluid, capped at surface, & location cleaned. Information from the offset well indicated that this well would be non-productive. Continental's option on this lease expired February 28, 1964.

Proposed plugging and abandonment procedure: (1) Spot 110 sx cmt plug 3350-3150, (2) 40 sack cmt plug 1950-1900', (3) 70 sack cmt plug from 400-320', (4) 10 sack cmt plug at surface.

Surface will be restored to its original condition and a four foot marker erected at the well site.

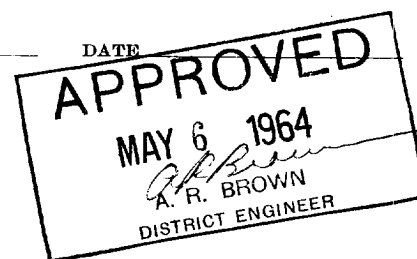

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
