Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 350' in Red Bed. Ran 11 jts., 329.10' of 13-3/8" OD 48# 8 R H-40 SS casing set at 348.7' and cemented with 350 sacks of neat cement. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 2:25 p.m., June 14, 1956. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours before testing for shut-off. Prior to and after drilling plug, 600 pounds pressure was applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute interval. Drilling resumed.
