Dear John:

A check of our records reveals that at the time your properties were transferred to Continental Oil Company, one well was not transferred to Continental, neither, was it plugged and abandoned. I have reference to the State "CS" #1-N, Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 35 East. The subject well was completed in August, 1960. On September 21, 1960, a notice of temporary abandonment was filed and we have heard nothing further regarding the status of the well.

In your letter of January 9, 1962, to this Commission, requesting cancellation of your Blanket Plugging Bond, you stated that all your properties together with records of your operations were transferred to Continental Oil Company. We would like to know, therefore, if we should contact Continental Oil Company regarding plugging of the above-mentioned well.
