On August 4, 1960 the subject well was bottomed at 12,242. All potential producing formations were found to be non-productive of oil or gas. On August 6, 1960 25 sax cement plugs were placed as follows:

Bonesprings-----7000-7075
San Andres-----4900-4975
Base 8 5/8"-----3730-3795

The 8 5/8" head was capped with a valve. The well is temporarily abandoned in this condition.
