DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran Baker Model "K" Cast-iron cement retainer on 2 1/2" EUE tubing & set @ 5980. Displaced oil in casing w/water & broke formation w/500#. Squeezed all perfs in 7" casing w/250 sax regular cement. FP 1900#. Shut well in @3:00am 11-22-54. On December 10, ran McCullough Magnetector survey & found free point in 7" casing @4625', cut 7" casing @4615' w/jet pipe cutters & pulled 4615' 7" casing from hole including 264' of 29# N-80 R-3 and 4351' of 23# N-80 R-3.

Set 50 sax cement plug in 9-5/8" casing from 4430-4560 & 10 sax cement plug @ surface w/4" iron pipe projecting 4' above ground.

Plugged & abandoned December 13, 1954.
