A cast-iron bridge plug was set at 9930 and two sacks of cement were dumped on top of the plug. The 7" casing was perforated at 6010-18 and 6024-30 with 7 jets per foot. Tubing was run to 6040 with packer set @5980. Swabbed dry. Acidized perfs w/500 gals MA. Swabbed dry. Acidized perfs w/1000 gals 15% regular, swabbed dry. Acidized perfs w/3000 gals 15% regular, swabbed dry.
