13-3/8" 48# H-40 ST&C R-243 8rd thd casing cemented @486' w/225 sax regular plus 225 sax Diemix plus 50 sax regular w/2% Calcium Chloride.

Ran 12 1/2" bit, but found no cement in 13-3/8" casing, so squeezed 300 sax reg around casing shoe w/Baker Model "K" retainer set @433. Squeeze pressures from 200-500# psi. Tested 13-3/8" casing for water shut-off w/800 psi for 30 mins, OK.
