15" OD Armo Slip-Joint surface casing was set @ 334' with 225 sac Portland cement, by Halliburton Cementing Company. Was allowed to stand for 24 hours, then plug was drilled and hole bailed dry, then allowed to stand for one hour undisturbed. A satisfactory shutoff was obtained.
