- D.S.T. #2: November 20, 1957, from 10,059-10,149'. Tool open 3 hours. Recovered 1140' oil and 660' heavy oil and gas cut mud with no water.
- D.S.T. #3: December 8, 1957, from 10,541-10,650'. Tool open 3-1/2 hours. Recovered 1000' of free oil.
- D.S.T. #4: January 5, 1958, from 11,580-11,635' with 2000' water blanket. Tool open 3 hours. Recovered 2000' water blanket, 1220' slightly mud cut oil and 46' oil below circ. sub.
- D.S.T. #5: January 11, 1958, from 11,658-11,735<sup>1</sup>. Tool open 2 hours and 57 minutes. Flowed 50.75 barrels of 48.6<sup>o</sup> gravity oil/hr., 1/4" choke, surface press: 525#. Reversed 120 barrels oil from 4" drill pipe, no water.
- D.S.T. #6: January 16, 1958, from 11,730,11,848' using 2000'water cushion. Tool open 130 minutes. Recovered 2000' of oil and gas cut water blanket, 6200' of sulfur water cut oil (10% water) and 350' of oil cut sulfur water (50% oil).
