### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Fisher & Lowrie-State Well  
No. 1 in NM<sup>1</sup> of Sec. 11 Twp. 18-S., Rge. 36-E.,  
N. M. P. M., Oil Field, Lea County.  
We plan to commence work on In May, 1933.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows: After drilling to 5505' and plugging back to 5171', and shooting with 200 qts., extensive swabbing showed well would produce not over 32½ bbls. a day which is not commercial at this depth. In order to recover casing and equipment and stop petty thievery of surface equipment, we feel it advisable to plug and abandon the well. A copy of the daily drilling reports showing the production swabbed is enclosed herewith for your information.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

Standing with master gate and control head shut in.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows: Since present bottom of hole is 5171', and the pay horizon from 5154 to 5163', we propose to kill well and plug back with cement to 5130'; plug with mud up to 3120'; place 10' cement plug from 3120 to 3110' to protect overlying salt that bottoms at 3080'; fill with mud to 2010'; place 10' cement plug from 2010 to 2000' to protect top of salt which is found at 2025'; fill with mud to surface, and cement off surface water if same is not already cemented behind the present 15½" surface casing.
