FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The subject well was spudded April 10, 1945 and drilled to a total depth of 5522' in the San Andres lime with rotary tools; DST taken from 5420-5522 indicated no shows of oil, gas or water, and we propose to abandon well at its present depth in the following manner:

Fill hole with heavy mud then set 25-sack cement plug in bottom of 9-5/8" casing which was set with 250 sacks cement through the salt section at 3288, then part the 9-5/8 and recover as much as possible (estimate 2550'); place a 25-sack cement plug at 2000' which is just above the salt section and a 25-sack cement plug at top of 13-3/8" casing which was cemented from 292' to surface. The hole will be kept full of heavy mud laden fluid between all cement plugs. The cellar and pits will be filled and surface terrain restored to its natural contours.
