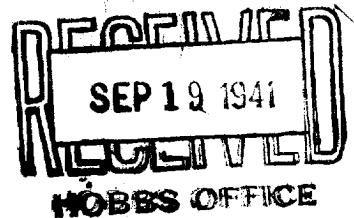

SECTION 101-101-101-101

1. The purpose of this section is to provide for the establishment of a system of public health services for the people of the State of New York.

2. The system of public health services shall be established by the Department of Health, which shall be responsible for the planning, development, and operation of the system.

3. The system of public health services shall be organized into a hierarchy of levels, including the State level, the county level, and the local level.

4. The system of public health services shall be financed by the State, the county, and the local government.

5. The system of public health services shall be subject to the oversight and control of the State Board of Health.

6. The system of public health services shall be subject to the oversight and control of the State Board of Health.
