Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held on the proposed amendments to the regulations governing the practice of medicine in the State of New York, at the State Office Building, Albany, New York, on the 15th day of June, 1934, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

The amendments proposed are as follows: (1) To amend the regulations governing the practice of medicine in the State of New York, Chapter 100, Section 100.1, by adding the following: "The Board of Regents may, from time to time, suspend or revoke the license of any physician who is found to be incompetent or who is guilty of professional misconduct."

It is the policy of the State of New York to protect the public health and safety by maintaining the highest standards of medical practice. The Board of Regents, in its capacity as the governing body of the State Department of Health, has the honor to announce that it has received the following proposals for amendments to the regulations governing the practice of medicine in the State of New York:

1. To amend the regulations governing the practice of medicine in the State of New York, Chapter 100, Section 100.1, by adding the following: "The Board of Regents may, from time to time, suspend or revoke the license of any physician who is found to be incompetent or who is guilty of professional misconduct."

2.
