Subject well was tested in compliance with NMOCG memorandum dated 8-25-53.

Temperature Survey: Two copies of the temperature survey are attached.

Pressure Survey: BHP at datum 605 psi. Results of pressure survey are reported on form C-124.

Bradenhead check: With tubing pressure 275 psi, 7" casing pressure 600 psi, 9 5/8" casing pressure 750 psi, and 13" casing pressure 0 psi, the bradenhead was opened. Mud and water flowed for five minutes and died. The 7" casing pressure remained at 600 psi, and the 9 5/8" at 0 psi after shut-in.

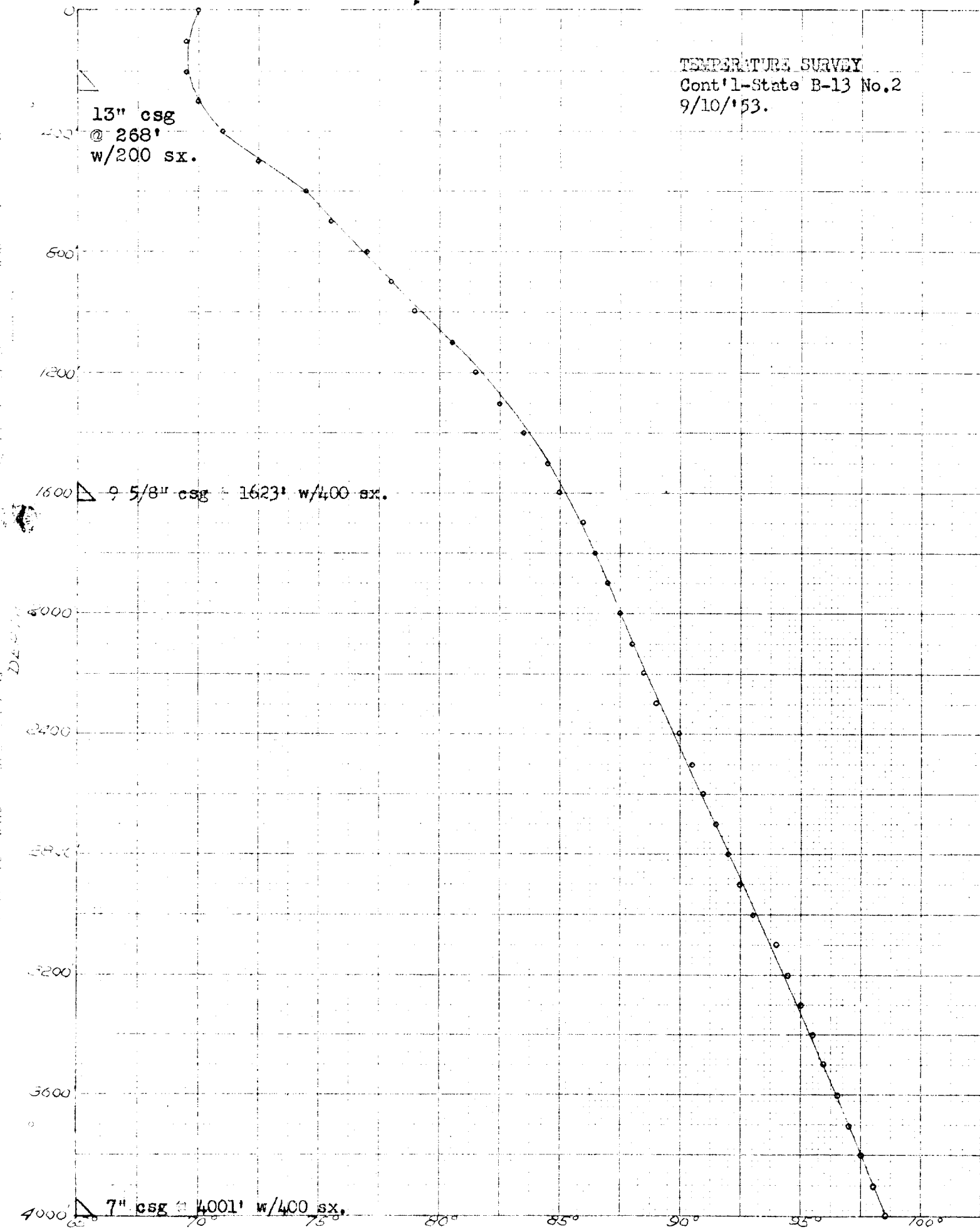
