NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State A-1554
Well No. 1 in SE of NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 13S, R. 37E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on 8/24/35. 10-3/4" 40# lb. casing was cemented in Red Bed
formation at a depth of 221' feet on 8/22/35 19
225 sacks of Lehigh cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Process

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Dry feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Shell & Continental

Additional information:

Cemented 10-3/4" Casing in 15 1/2" hole, at 221' W/225-sacks lehigh cement Plug to be drilled, and casing bailed dry, and allowed to stand two hours undisturbed.
