FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well made 100% water from the Hobbs sand. We propose to plug and abandon as follows:

1. Run tubing open ended to 4242' T.D. and lay 25 sk. cement plug.
2. Make cut at approximately 2600' on 5-1/2" casing & attempt to recover casing.
3. Put 25 sk. plug in and out of stub of 5-1/2".
4. Put 25 sk. plug in bottom of 8-5/8" surface at 341'.
5. Put 10 sk. plug in top of 8-5/8" w/ 4" x 5' pipe marker showing well designation.

Offset operators are being notified of these plans by a copy of this report by registered mail.
