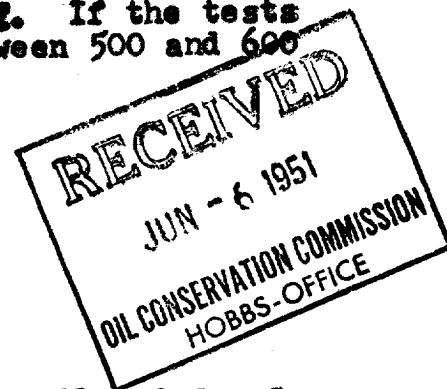

At 12:01 AM, June 6, 1951, 24 hours will have elapsed since cementing the 13 3/8" casing at 356 ft. with 450 sacks of neat cement circulated to the surface. At the above time, the casing will be tested before and after drilling the plug. If the tests are satisfactory, drilling will be resumed. Between 500 and 600 psi pressure will be used on both tests.
