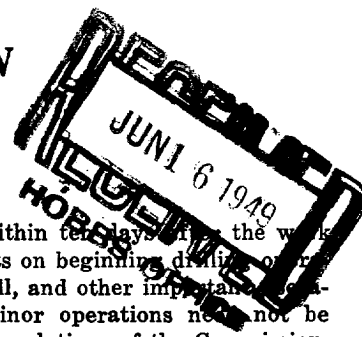

T.D. 6021' Mudded hole to surface with heavy mud. Spotted 25 sacks cement 5919' to 6000'. Shot 5-1/2" casing off at 4600' and pulled. Placed 25 sack cement plug 4600' to 4520'. Spotted 35 sacks cement plug from 3160' to 3050'. Placed 10' cement plug in top of 8-5/8" casing with 4" pipe marker. Well plugged and abandoned.
