

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Halliburton acidized with 500 gallons 15%. 30 barrels flush oil. Maximum casing pressure 2025#. Tubing pressure 1000 to 3350#. Swabbed two hours recovered flush oil and acid water. Swabbed six hours, recovered 10 barrels per hour sulphur water, very slight show of oil, small amount of gas.


