Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used, and results obtained.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 4250 Lins. Ran 134½ joints (4239.06') of 5½" OD 14# ER J-55 SS Casing set at 4248.50'. Cemented with 425 sacks neat cement. Plug was down at 6:30 PM, October 17, 1959. Ran temperature survey-top of cement 2710'. Drilled out to 4246' and tested casing with 1000 lbs. pressure with satisfactory results. Prior to testing casing, cement was allowed to set 26 hours before testing for shut-off.


