DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above described well was treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX Acid.

As a result of the treatment, oil and gas production was increased from $\frac{1}{2}$ (one) barrel of oil per hour with a very small amount of gas, to approximately 8 barrels of oil per hour with gas at rate of 169M per day. Gas-oil ratio 780.

The above report is made on a test taken after the well had flowed 8 Hrs. and cleaned up and reproduced the oil used to follow acid.
