Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas inspector if possible.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation State-E Well No. 2 in the NW 1/4 of NW 4 of Sec. 21, T. 18 - S, R. 37 - E N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above described well was re-treated with 4000 Gals. Dowell XX acid.

As a result of the re-treatment the production of the well was raised from 8 Bbls oil with gas at the rate of 169M per day, to 11 Bbls. oil per hour with gas at the rate of 695M per day.

The above report was made from a test taken after the well had flowed 7 hours and had cleaned itself of oil used to follow the acid. Water percentage was 6/10%.
