Observed pressures 10-2-53

13-3/8" - 0#

9-5/8" - 800#

7" - 700#

Observed pressures 10-6-53

13-3/8" - 0#

9-5/8" - 800#

7" - 700#; blew down to 200# in 1 hour then closed in. There was no drop in 9-5/8" pressure.

Observed pressures 10-7-53

13-3/8" - 0#

9-5/8" - 800#

7" - 300#; blew down to 0# in 15 minutes. There was no drop in 9-5/8" pressure.

Results: Since the 7" pressure exhausted and there was no drop in 9-5/8" pressure, there is no communication between 7" and 9-5/8" strings. The energy source for the 7" pressure is the open hole above the formation packer.
