This well was treated by Dowell with 1,000 gallons (61-59) acid March 8, 1934 and loaded with 50 barrels oil.  
 Official test made on March 8th which showed following:

Tubing test - - - - - 5,896 bbls. oil & 13,199 MCF gas.  
 Pressure on tubing 60# and Casing 60#.  
 Casing & tubing wide open - 8,616 bbls. oil & 20,793 MCF gas.  
 No back pressure on open.
