DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The Well had been drilled to 216' and 15 1/2" 70# casing was landed at 214' and cemented with 225 sacks, by Halliburton Method, on February 2, 1933. on February 10th the cement plug was drilled, Hole bailed dry and left undisturbed for 3 Hours, at the Expiration of that time the hole was still dry, which indicated an excellent water shut off.
