NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State B 25 Lease
Well No. 1 in NW of Sec. 25, T. 18 South, R. 37 East,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on January 9 19 33 15 1/2" 70# casing was 150# cemented in Red Bed
formation at a depth of 214 feet on January 2, 19 33
225 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 216 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
