INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be submitted and filed in QUADRUPLET with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced, and the transporter that is permitted to be a transporter authorized to transport oil and gas therefrom. After approval and certification has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, a copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the Commission and one copy retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new permit is required to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in transporter, except in the case of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than the allowable production for one proration period; the operator shall, in such case, by certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office and the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and accepted; such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This permit shall be signed, executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall be submitted, permit for the line number and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (a) A change in ownership changes
- (b) The transporter is changed, or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, explain fully under the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases where this permit is filed to cover a change in operating ownership, the transporter or the transporter designated to move oil or gas, show under

- REMARKS: (a) previous owner or operator and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each producing unit as designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
