Well was completed in June, 1935. Water was found in the San Andres and well was plugged back to 4166' with 7" casing at 4039' and completed in the Grayburg zone. Production has now declined to 25 barrels of oil per day with no water. It is proposed to pull tubing, clean out well to FB depth of 4166', place 4' hydramite protection plug from 4166' to 4162', and sand frac with 10,000 gallons of heavy oil plus 10,000' sand from 4039' to 4162'.


Attached you will find the original and four (4) copies of your Form O-102 covering a notice of intention to plug back and sand frac the above subject well.
